The completed NCSD physical exam form and proof of insurance must be given to the host school's main office staff and approved before participating in a practice.

 - a. Home School students: A student ID # is created in Infinite Campus by contacting the NCSD Home School Coordinator at 253-3150.
 - b. Private School and Virtual School students: A student ID # is created by contacting the NCSD Athletics & Activities Department at 253-5462.
3. Once the student ID # is created, Home, Virtual and Private School parents/guardians will need to complete the online Parental Acknowledgement information. This is done by logging on to natronaschools.org and clicking on the Infinite Campus Parent Portal icon. Once in the Parent Portal, click on More, select Parental Acknowledgement, enter the student ID # that was provided to you, and complete and submit the electronic activity/sport registration questions.
4. All secondary students participating in an NCSD activity must have catastrophic insurance coverage. If a student is not enrolled at Natrona County School District, call (577-0614) or go to the Wyoming High School Activities Association (WHSAA) (6571 E. 2nd Street, Casper, WY 82609) to purchase WHSAA Catastrophic Liability Insurance. Once purchased, provide Proof of Payment to the NCSD host school.
